(If 3 heats top 3 from each heat to go into the final)

Event 2: Ratings Race - distance 1 ¼ miles. HandicapEntry fee £45 per horsePrize money1st £3752nd £1013rd £75

Handicap trail for each race will be taken from the lowest rated horse in each race, 10 points = 10Yards. Max 2 races entries taken on a first come first served basis.

Event 3: Maiden Races for non winners - distance 1 mile. Ballot for positionEntry Fee £35 per horsePrize Money1st £3502nd £1013rd £75

Where possible (subject to numbers) maidens will run together, however subject to entries there may be a requirement to hold a ballot to remove horses and place them off the gate in Event 1 with a 10 yard advantage. The committee will split for owners in Event 3 only. Max 2 races entries taken on a first come first served basis.

Event 4 – C Class Drivers Race - distance 1 ¹/₄ miles. Handicap

Handicap trail for each race will be taken from the lowest rated horse in each race, 10 points = 10Yards. Subject to a minimum of 8 entries.

Event 5 – Qualifier/Workout/Driving Test – distance 1 mile.

Entry fee £25 per horse

Mares Allowance OR C Class Driver Allowance can be claimed but MUST be indicated next to **horse's name (MARES ALLOWANCE)** or **drivers name (C CLASS**) at time of entry.

Any horse not withdrawn (with BHRC office) by 10am on Monday 17th July is liable for full entry fee. The committee / promotor reserves the right to alter the above conditions if circumstances dictate.

If saddlecloths are not returned by the trainer to the collection point a £50 fine will be imposed on the trainer.

Random pre and post-race integrity tests will be taken.
