Event 1: Open Handicap -1m500yds for top 30 rated horses entered. Entry Fee £55.

No split for owner/trainer/driver. 30 entries needed to run.

Horses on same ratings will ballot for position and if needed to attain the cut off point for the top 30 rated horses

Trails to be taken from lowest rated horse entered working up. 10 points = 10 yards.

Final- 1st £1000, 2nd £300, 3rd £100 – first 3 from heats qualify for final.

Heats- 1st £500, 2nd £200, 3rd £100

Event 2: Maiden – 1m80yds. Horses with no lifetime win. Entry Fee £40

All balloted for position. First 20 entered horses will be allocated a place in the race, remainder may be reserves.

If we have more than 1 race we will try to split horses with same owner. 1^{st} £350, 2^{nd} £100, 3^{rd} £50

Event 3: Straight handicap ratings races- 1m500yds. Horses not eligible for above events. **Entry Fee £45**

Trails to be taken from lowest rated horse entered working up. 10 points = 10 yards. First 20 horses entered will be allocated a place in the race, remainder may be reserves. If possible we will try and split horses for owners.

1st £400, 2nd £100, 3rd £50

Event 4 – Qualifiers. Entry Fee £25. To be held after racing.

Event 5- 'Le Trot' Race. Max two races, entries via TROTBritain. Prize money paid by TROTBritain

All entries via the BHRC online system. (Apart from Le Trot)

Any horse on provisional start sheet is liable for full entry fee.

The Brough Athletic Sports committee reserve the right to alter the above conditions if circumstances dictate.

Horses will be framed under the National Ratings Based Handicap System.

No jogging between races, jogging only permitted if condition of track allows.

Horse's starting position on gate or line determined by handicap rating; horse with lowest rating placed inside horse with higher rating. Horses with same handicap rating B.F.P.

Appleby Races Track Rules

- 1. Officials: BHRC stewards, Integrity Officer, Eden Valley Stewards and gate stewards for Appleby will wear body cameras to record the process of racing and integrity testing at our events.
- 2. Any horse entered at Brough Races could be subjected to sampling for Integrity Testing. Horses selected in accordance with sections F16 & Y of the BHRC Rules and Regulations.
- 3. In accordance with Appendix V of the BHRC Rules and Regulations, there will be an appointed area for testing. All horses chosen for sampling will be escorted to this area and may be stripped of harness and washed down once present at the appointed area (water and equipment to be provided by the trainer). The horse passport will be required.

In accordance with section Y of the BHRC Rules, the trainer or their representative may be present to witness the collection of the sample. Should a trainer choose not to witness this process (or nominate a representative), they must sign a declaration before the sample is taken in which they agree that the integrity of the sampling procedure will not be questioned later. No additional personnel may accompany the horse due to Health & Safety.

- 4. Brough Races will be using the drone for stewarding purposes.
- 5. Saddle cloths must be returned to the declaration office. A fine of £50 will be charged for each number cloth not returned.

All vehicles: cars & wagons to enter the race field by the Grammar school entrance.

The bridge entrance is for pedestrians only. Horseboxes will be checked, stowaways found will result in all occupants removed from track & horses will not be allowed to run.
